This was the first AGM, chaired by Pradeep Raman, president of the credit union.




Pradeep Raman, President, Huggins Credit Union Board of Directors chaired their 62nd Annual General Meeting

## **ELECTION RESULTS FOR 2023 - 2024 PERIOD Supervisory Committee**

The three committee members, Ayanna Antoine, Gailann Brathwaite and Glen Narine will return to serve on the supervisory committee for the 2023/24 term. Ayanna Antoine will serve for a full year since replacing David La Borde during the last 2022/23 period.

The members elected the three-member committee from a field of five nominees. Glen Narine got 57 votes, Gailann Brathwaite got 55 votes, and Ayanna Antoine received 44 votes.




2023/24 Supervisory Committee

#### **Credit Committee**

The membership attending the AGM, elected from a field of 6 nominees, the following members to serve on the 2023/24 credit committee: Derrick Murray 74 votes, Sarah Durrant 74 votes, Narda Coker 44 votes, Shalleen Wiltshire 64 votes, Carlene King 64 votes and newcomer Kefira McLean with 51 votes.

Narda Coker who received 44 votes, will be the first and only alternate.

### **Board of Directors**

The 62nd AGM saw six members volunteering of their time to serve on the Board of Directors. The membership elected Wilma Abbott-Romany (73 votes), Abbey Acosta (60 votes), Tribowan Singh (53 votes), and newcomer Heathcliffe Samlalsingh (52 votes).



The 1st and 2nd alternates Rachel Briggs (51 votes) and Raynette Trisha Ochoa (33 votes) will serve one year.
